

Formula for yardage

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Step 1) Calculate the number of stitches in your garment. For example # of cast ons x # of rows = total number of stitches. If you have sleeves add those totals to the body number of stitches.

Step 2) Measure how many inches 4 stitches makes.

Step 3) Multiply your total number of stitches by the number from step 2.

Step 4) Divide your step 3 total by 36 (36" equals 1 yard) and you'll have your yardage number!

Example:

Using the numbers from my Summer Lovin Tank size small.

My step 1 total is 17,388 total stitches

I have 4 stitches in 1"

So I would multiply $17388 \times 1 = 17388$

Finally dividing $17388/36 = 483$ yards!
